



attended the Fancy Food Show in New York at the end of June. It is a huge trade show, attracting a wide range of buyers domestically and globally. It had a 21% increase in attendance by retailers and is the largest specialty food event in North America. Attendees are specialty retailers, foodservice, restaurants, press, influencers, and trend spotters.

There were 2,200 vendors exhibiting 180,000 products and it took days to cover the space of the New York Javits Center. Food is no different than any other category. It has trends coming in and outgoing. Not all these trends will be covered in this article but they will be addressed over several articles.

Sales of specialty foods and beverages are projected to reach \$207 billion in 2023. There are many new start-up vendors in a special section called the incubator and there are branded established vendors from all parts of the U.S. and hundreds of international vendors who can ship directly or have hooked up to U.S. distributors.

There is an award presentation called **Sofi™** judged by buyers, chefs, influencers, industry leaders and other leaders in the food world. They judge 53 categories to come up with the winners who receive the **Sofi™** trophy and within each of the 53 categories there is also a ranking of gold, silver, bronze winners like the Olympics. I am outlining this if you read on in my article it might reference the **Sofi™** (specialty food industry association).

Each year I cover this show for the Minneapolis Mart and suggest a list of items I feel the retailers might try and the vendor contact information. This is one of several articles I will write about mixing gourmet food with gifts this year.
