Buyers should expect consumers to lean into products that feel joyful, nostalgic, social, and multi-generational as several major events drive purchasing throughout the season.

MOTHER'S DAY & THE RISE OF SOCIAL HOBBIES



Mother's Day on May 10 continues to inspire gifting across categories, but this year the biggest growth extends beyond traditional gifts. Mahjong, Canasta, crafting, and puzzle culture remain strong lifestyle drivers for consumers of all ages. These hobbies are no longer just for mothers—they are becoming family-centered activities enjoyed across generations.

Puzzles continue evolving with creative formats including 3-D structures such as cars, homes, and circus themes. Packaging is also becoming part of the trend, with tin-shaped containers, novelty zipper carriers, and collectible designs replacing traditional boxes.

Across categories, playful motifs remain important. Florals, dots, and mixed stripes are appearing alongside food-inspired icons including cherries, strawberries, olives, and citrus. These themes are extending into jewelry, candles, accessories, tabletop, and novelty gifting. Expect continued demand for whimsical items such as olive earrings, fruit-themed hair clips, and food-inspired décor.

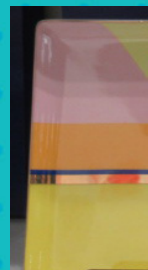
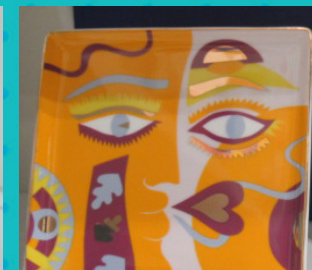
FATHER'S DAY AND SPORTS ENTERTAINMENT TRENDS

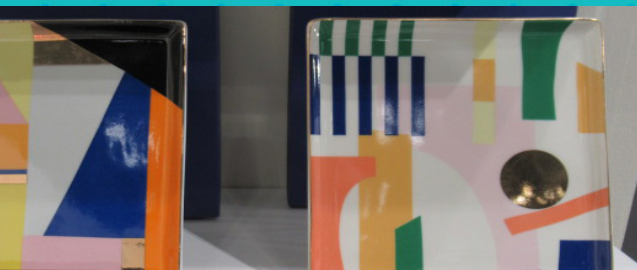

JULY 4TH AND AMERICA'S 250TH ANNIVERSARY

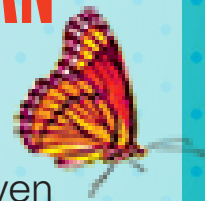
